

Information about group visits at the Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier – updated

Group visits WITHOUT a guide at the Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier

We ask groups such as school classes, associations and clubs, etc., to register their visit in advance by sending an email to muspaed.rlmt@gdke.rlp.de.

The **maximum group size permitted is 5 people** plus one chaperone.

The following hygiene and protective measures must be observed during the visit:

- Face masks must be worn. Exceptions apply to children under the age of six and people with health-related or physical restrictions that prevent them from wearing a mask (a medical certificate is required as proof).
- A distance of at least 1.5 metres from other visitors and museum staff must be maintained at all times. This does not apply to members of the same family or household.
- Please observe the maximum number of visitors allowed per room.
- The tour of the Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier has been designed as a one-way route and will stay this way until further notice.
- Hand sanitiser stations can be found throughout the Museum. Please wash or sanitise your hands regularly.
- Each household must fill out a contact form.
- Only the halls in the “Roman Section” can be visited by entire groups at the same time.

- Currently, guided tours are only possible in the “Roman Section”. The maximum number of visitors for a tour of the Roman Section of the permanent exhibition is 5 plus a guide.
- The maximum tour length is 60 mins, Cost is € 55 plus the admission fee (group and family discounts available)
